Tristram sen. removed from Haverhill, thence to Newbury, thence to
Salisbury, thence in 1660 to Nantucket (of which the island he & children
purchased ~~the~~ three tenths Sept. 2. 1659 of Thomas Mayhew) & carried
with him his mother (who died May 1661 aged 74) & the his children James,
Mary, John & Stephen, leaving Peter with Major Rich. Waldron of Dover
Tristram in Newbury, who at the age of 19 married (1) the widow Somerby
daughter of Capt. Edmund Greenleaf & brother to Capt. Stephen Greenleaf
who married his sister Elizabeth. Tristram sen. died in 1681 aged 46.
Tristram Jun. died Feb. 14. 1703 aged & left 10 children viz.
