FATHER NOTES: Francis KENDALL ALIAS MILES

**Tax List (1655):** Francis is the only Kendall on the list.

**Court (20 December 1658):** Francis is stated as aged about 38.

**Court (1658/9):** No date and no age for Francis was given. Court book stated only that Francis Kendall had given testimony, not where or for what case.

**Court (5 April 1659):** Abt age 39 at deposition

**Court (March 1662 or April 1662):** Francis Kendall signed petition of Samuel Walker of Woburn to still and sell strong drink.

**Court (31 March 1662):** Docket states document is located in Vol 21 p. 287 in the Probate books. There is an inventory of a 1740 will on that page, not a court judgment. This particular volume has all different time periods from 1636-1766 and appears to be items left out of previous volumes. Additionally, there is a second Vol 21 which covers 1718-1720. Page 287 of that volume has no Francis Kendall.

**Court (2 February 1662/3):** Stated Francis Kendall, about age 48, gave testimony with Thomas Dutton concerning lands in Woburn.

**Court (18 October 1672):** Listed as age 57.

**Death (9 May 1708):** Woburn Town record month and date not listed in printed book, but apparently some source lists 9 May as it was found in several pedigrees.

MOTHER NOTES: Mary TIDD

**Death (1705):** Woburn VR recorded this death, but only with the year as the day and month were not in the printed book (which had blanks showing they could not be read).

CHILD NOTES: Thomas KENDALL

**Death (by 29 January 1730):** Sons Samuel, Thomas, Eleazer and Ralph agreed that Samuel should be the administrator for the estate. No death record in Woburn exists for a Thomas Kendall who died prior to May of that year and that event appears to belong to a child.

CHILD NOTES: Mary KENDALL

**Death (17 January 1722/3):** Note, the death of a Mary Reed on 17 Jan 1722/3 states: Mary, widow of \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_, Jan 17, 1722.

CHILD NOTES: Hannah KENDALL

**Death (21 December 1721):** Not in any VR database for Massachusetts. Only death for a Hannah Green in 1721 which was found in VR was for the wife or widow of Joseph Green. The article in the Connecticut Nutmegger does give her death date, but not the place.

CHILD NOTES: Abigail KENDALL

**Death (12 October 1734):** Note, this death is not in the Lexington VR. The earliest Reed or Read death there is 1854.
