## FAMILY NOTES

**Marriage (by 1616):** The marriage may or may not have taken place in Sherrington. That is where Ralph and his wife were living in 1616. If Susan and Mary were born before Thomas, the marriage could have taken place a few years earlier. No marriage record has been found for Ralph in the Sherrington area.

## FATHER NOTES: Ralph KENDALL ALIAS MILES

**Birth (1585–1595):** Based only on christening of first known child, in Sherrington in 1616, though other children

could have been born earlier.

**Will written (1 October 1657):** Enough of the will is torn off that the place in Middlesex is missing. It's possibly Enfield, where Ralph's youngest son, Richard, was living. However between May 1657 and March 1658/9, Ralph must have moved back to Newport Pagnell.

CHILD NOTES: Mary KENDALL ALIAS MILES

**Birth (by about 1633):** The 1654 Deed of Gift from Ralph Kendall to his son, John, mentioned Mary with her married name of Heatley

CHILD NOTES: Thomas KENDALL ALIAS MILES

**Court (30 March 1665):** Note, Francis also appears to have signed the same or a similar petition.

**General:** Admitted Freeman in Reading 10 May 1648

CHILD NOTES: Elizabeth KENDALL ALIAS MILES

**General:** No additional information has been found on Elizabeth Kendall als Mills in any record in the Newport Pagnell/Sherrington area.

CHILD NOTES: Francis KENDALL ALIAS MILES

**Tax List (1655):** Francis is the only Kendall on the list.

**Court (20 December 1658):** Francis is stated as aged about 38.

**Court (1658/9):** No date and no age for Francis was given. Court book stated only that Francis Kendall had given testimony, not where or for what case.

**Court (5 April 1659):** Abt age 39 at deposition

**Court (March 1662 or April 1662):** Francis Kendall signed petition of Samuel Walker of Woburn to still and sell strong drink.

**Court (31 March 1662):** Docket states document is located in Vol 21 p. 287 in the Probate books. There is an inventory of a 1740 will on that page, not a court judgment. This particular volume has all different time periods from 1636-1766 and appears to be items left out of previous volumes. Additionally, there is a second Vol 21 which covers 1718-1720. Page 287 of that volume has no Francis Kendall.

**Court (2 February 1662/3):** Stated Francis Kendall, about age 48, gave testimony with Thomas Dutton concerning lands in Woburn.

**Court (18 October 1672):** Listed as age 57.

**Death (9 May 1708):** Woburn Town record month and date not listed in printed book, but apparently some source lists 9 May as it was found in several pedigrees.

CHILD NOTES: Richard KENDALL ALIAS MILES

**Tax List (1666):** Richard had 6 hearths, some of which might have been used for his business.

**Court (1 February 1670/1):** John Kendall als. Mills Jr. (son of Richard's brother, John) brought a case against his uncle Richard and William Bristowe concerning money from rent he thought he ought to inherit upon reaching his majority.
